

High Award Checklist



Girl Scout Bronze Award

Prerequisites

- A registered Girl Scout Member for Junior grade level (4th or 5th grade)
- Completed one Junior grade level Journey
Check one Journey
 - AGENT of Change: Use your power!
 - MOVING! Energize yourself and others
 - aMUSE: Try on new roles
 - Think Like an Engineer
 - Think Like a Programmer
 - Think Like a Citizen Scientist
 - Outdoor Journey
- Take Action Project – Select a group project that makes an improvement within the Girl Scout or local community.

Troop Leader - Girls lead the project with the guidance of the troop leader.

Team Members - Must be part of a troop or a small group of girls (this is the only high award that cannot be completed individually (unless registered as an iGirl)).

Process:

- Watch Bronze Award video (troop leader) or complete the self-study booklet
- Build your Girl Scout team
- Explore your community
- Girls generate a project idea by identifying issues that they personally care about within their community.
- Make a plan
- Put your plan in motion
- Spread the word
- Complete Bronze Award Report form
- Leader reviews and submits completed forms and pin purchase form

Required Hours

- 20 Hours (Remember to have each group member track her specific hours for this award)

Sustainability

- Group project makes an improvement within the Girl Scout or local community.



Girl Scout Silver Award

Prerequisites

- A registered Girl Scout Member for Cadette grade level (6th, 7th, or 8th grade)
- Completed one Cadette grade level Journey
Check one Journey
 - aMAZE: The Twists and Turns of Getting Along
 - Breathe
 - MEdia
 - Outdoor Journey
- Take Action Project – Individual or group project makes the local neighborhood or community better.

Troop Leader – Girl begin to take the lead.

Team Members – Can work as an individual or as a small group.

Process:

- Watch Silver Award video (girl and troop leader) or complete the self-study booklet
- Identify issues you care about
- Build your Silver Award team or decide to go solo
- Explore your community
- Pick your project
- Pick a plan to put your project in motion
- Reflect and share your story
- Complete Girl Scout Silver Award Report Form, Time Log, and Expense Sheet (each girl must complete).
- Leader reviews and submits completed forms and pin purchase form

Required Hours

- 50 Hours (Remember to have each group member track her specific hours for this award)

Sustainability

- Girls plan for sustainability in the project plan and implementation within their community.



Girl Scout Gold Award

Prerequisites

- A registered Girl Scout Member for Senior or Ambassador grade level (9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade)
- Earned Silver Award as a Cadette plus one Senior or Ambassador Journey (check one Journey)

OR

- Complete two Senior or Ambassador Journeys (Check two Journeys)

Senior Journeys

- World: The Power of Advocacy
- Justice
- BLISS: Live it! Give it!
- Outdoor Journey

Ambassador Journeys

- Girltopia
- Sow What
- Mission: Sisterhood!
- Outdoor Journey

- Individual project that makes a lasting difference in the local community, region or beyond.

Troop Leader – Individual girl led project

Team Members – Must be an individual project – one person

Process:

- Watch Gold Award video (advisor and girl) or complete the self-study booklet
- Use your values and skills to identify a community issue you care about where you can make a lasting change (beyond the Girl Scout community).
- Submit a project proposal council via email or mail at least six weeks before your anticipated project start date. Council staff will notify you of project status. Council approval is required before you can continue working on your project.
- Create a plan, take action
- Educate and inspire
- Complete Gold Award Final Report, Time Log, and Budget Sheet and submit to council for approval

Required Hours

- 80 Hours (Remember to track your specific hours for this award)

Sustainability

- Your project must achieve a sustainable and measureable impact so that it creates a lasting change in your community.
