OUTSTANDING LEADER/VOLUNTEER

Instructions: It is important to recognize leaders and volunteers for their hard work. Everyone who reaches higher than is expected deserves a "pat on the back" for their dedication to the organization and their commitment to the girls. If you know a leader who goes well above being a leader or a volunteer who puts in far more time and effort than the position requires, make sure they know that they are appreciated. Here's how to go about it.....

1. Complete the nomination and return to the Service Unit Adult Recognitions Committee for consideration.
2. Deadline for all nominations to be received by the service unit committee_____.
3. Service Unit Adult Recognitions Committee approves/rejects application.
4. Service Unit Adult Recognitions Committee Chair sends the Adult Recognitions request to GSBCD.
5. Pins/certificates are mailed to the Service Unit Administrator or Field Executive.
6. Outstanding Leader/Outstanding Volunteer pins are presented at a service unit meeting/event in the spring.
