To achieve the Gold Award, a Girl Scout must:

- Identify an issue she cares deeply about.
- Form a team of experts and community members to assist with her project.
- · Create a sustainable plan to address the issue.
- Mobilize her team and carry out the plan to make a difference.

Girl Scout Programming

At Girl Scouts of Black Diamond, our innovative programming is built around the **Four Pillars of Girl Scouting**. They include:

STEM. Girl Scouts spark early interest in STEM, helping girls build confidence, curiosity and skills in areas like coding, robotics and cybersecurity.

Life Skills. Through badge work in civic engagement, healthy living and communication, girls build resilience and the skills to lead healthy, purposeful lives.

Outdoors. From camp to local adventures, girls discover nature, develop leadership and grow happier, stronger and more connected to the world.

Entrepreneurship. Through the world's largest girl-led entrepreneurial program in the world, girls learn key skills like goal-setting, decision making, money management and people skills.

Naming Opportunities — \$10,000

Makerspace

Today, women in the workforce remain underrepresented in many fields — especially STEM, leadership and technical careers.

The Girl Scouts of Black Diamond Makerspace is designed to change that.

It houses art supplies, graphic design materials, culinary equipment, tools for entrepreneurship and more — giving girls hands-on opportunities to explore, create and envision themselves in new career possibilities.



Patch Programs

Girl Scout Patch Programs give girls the chance to participate in events where they can learn new skills, make connections and have fun. These events are offered when Girl Scouts of Black Diamond partners with local schools and youth organizations.

Patches may recognize participation in a troop activity or completion of a unique program. They are valuable because they:

- Engage girls of all ages in fun, handson activities that promote learning and community involvement.
- Help prevent learning loss during school breaks.
- Provide low-cost opportunities accessible to all socioeconomic backgrounds.


